Accessing the Results of the Composition Exam – Summer 2017

By O-Week, students and their advisors will be able to access the results of the Composition Exam that students took this summer by O-week. The exam establishes whether students must complete FWIS 100, Fundamentals of Academic Writing and Communication, before registering for the FWIS seminar that satisfies the graduation requirement. (FWIS 100 cannot be used to meet the graduation requirement.)

The following information will guide students and advisors through the steps needed to access the Comp Exam essay and grading rubric and results.

Student Instructions

To see your Comp Exam results, you will need to go to the Comp Exam Web site and follow the steps below:

1. Please go to <http://compexam.rice.edu/>
2. Click Log in Here; then enter your NetID and password.
3. Click the Comp Exam 2017 link to view your FWIS semester assignment and grading report.
4. If you wish to save and print your results, click Download as PDF

An e-mail will be sent to your Rice e-mail address when the results are available.

Advisor Instructions

Advisors will be able to retrieve the results of the Comp Exam of each of their advisees by following the steps below:

1. Please go to <http://compexam.rice.edu/>
2. Click Log in Here; then enter your NetID and password.
3. Under Exams to Review, click the exam year (2017). You will see an alphabetical listing of all students who took the exam. This list also includes each student's FWIS semester assignment (fall, spring, or FWIS 100 (fall) and FWIS (spring)).
4. Click View Essay to see the submitted essay and the grading report.
5. If you wish to save and print the student's results, click Download as PDF.
