WHY AUDIOLOGY AT TTUHSC?

With diverse clinical and research experiences throughout the span of the Audiology program, students have the opportunity to learn in diverse clinical environments and learn from faculty with a wide variety of clinical and research interests. The program schedule varies semester by semester, but students typically attend class two days a week and clinic one to two days a week for the first three years of the program. The fourth year consists of a full-time externship experience.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Au.D. program is competitive. The requirements listed below should be met to be eligible for admission consideration to the Au.D. program:

- + Completion of the Communication Sciences and Disorders Centralized Application Service (CSDCAS) application and the TTUHSC School of Health Professions supplemental application at www.ttuhsc.edu/ health-professions/admissions/application.aspx
- + A bachelor's degree in speech, language, and hearing sciences or a related field
- + A minimum cumulative and major GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- + Submission of GRE test scores (including verbal, quantitative and analytical writing sections)
- + Three letters of recommendation
- + TOEFL or IELTS scores if English is the second language

CURRICULUM

Our curriculum is at the forefront of audiology education with personalized opportunities, clinical and research experiences and interprofessional experiences.


Classes include fundamental courses, along with coursework related to assessment and treatment of avariety of hearing and balance areas. Example coursework includes:
